

Year 13 Results Day Flowchart

Log onto UCAS track at 8.30 This will tell you if you have secured a place at your first or second choice university.

You've received confirmation that you're into your first or second choice uni.

Congratulations! You don't need to do anything further. Your university will be in touch with all the information you need.

You haven't been accepted for either your first or second choice

Don't panic! You still have a number of options available to you.

Use Clearing Plus - on UCAS Track click 'See Matches' to see what courses you have been matched to automatically, based on your original course choices and your achieved grades. If you click 'Interested' for any of these courses the university can contact you. But you should also use the Clearing Search Tool to view all courses still available. Top tips for clearing:

1. Stay calm! Don't rush into any decisions - a university degree is expensive so you need to consider the course content and the university carefully before committing.
2. Be persistent and prepared to devote hours and hours on the phone to researching any courses and universities you are considering.
3. Keep checking clearing vacancies daily as new courses will continue to appear throughout August as other students change their minds about offers they've accepted.

You may now wish to consider the following options:

1. Exploring apprenticeships and job opportunities - Mrs Risman has been emailing about these all year so check back through your emails
2. Reapply next year (now that you know your grades) - if you want to do this via SJB you must contact Mrs Risman in September to make her aware
