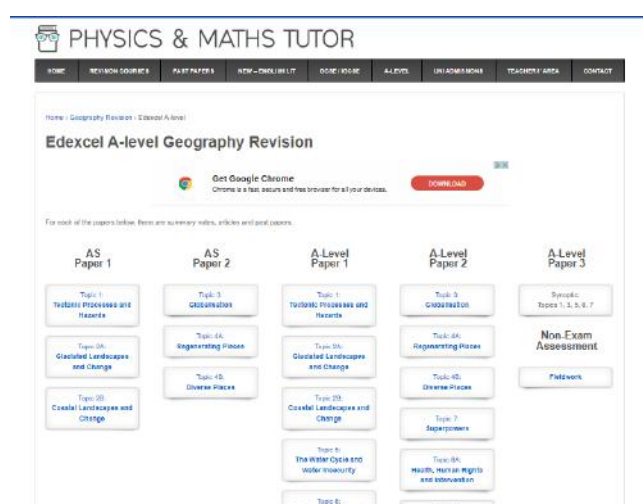


# Reading List for university preparation - Geography
