

Year 9 Homework 2023-24

The timetable below helps students to plan their time each week by giving them set subjects to complete each evening. Homework may be set on or prior to day listed below. The deadline will be made clear in the assignment and will always be at least the day after the slot in the fortnight when they are scheduled to complete the work.

In Year 9, the students are expected to complete the following homework each night:

- 20 minutes of reading per night - a combination of Sparks Reader (login details will be provided for each student) and their own material
- 2 x 30 minutes of 'subject' homework (ie. 60 minutes total)

Occasionally subjects may substitute several weeks' worth of homework for an extended project - this will be made clear in the assignment that is set.

All homework will be scheduled on Arbor and should be visible for students and parents, noting a clear deadline.

If there is a genuine and exceptional reason why a student has not completed their homework, they should email their teacher and let them know in advance of the deadline.
