I can discern the impact these beliefs have on the ways that religious people celebrate or live out their faith with reference to accurate divergent beliefs.

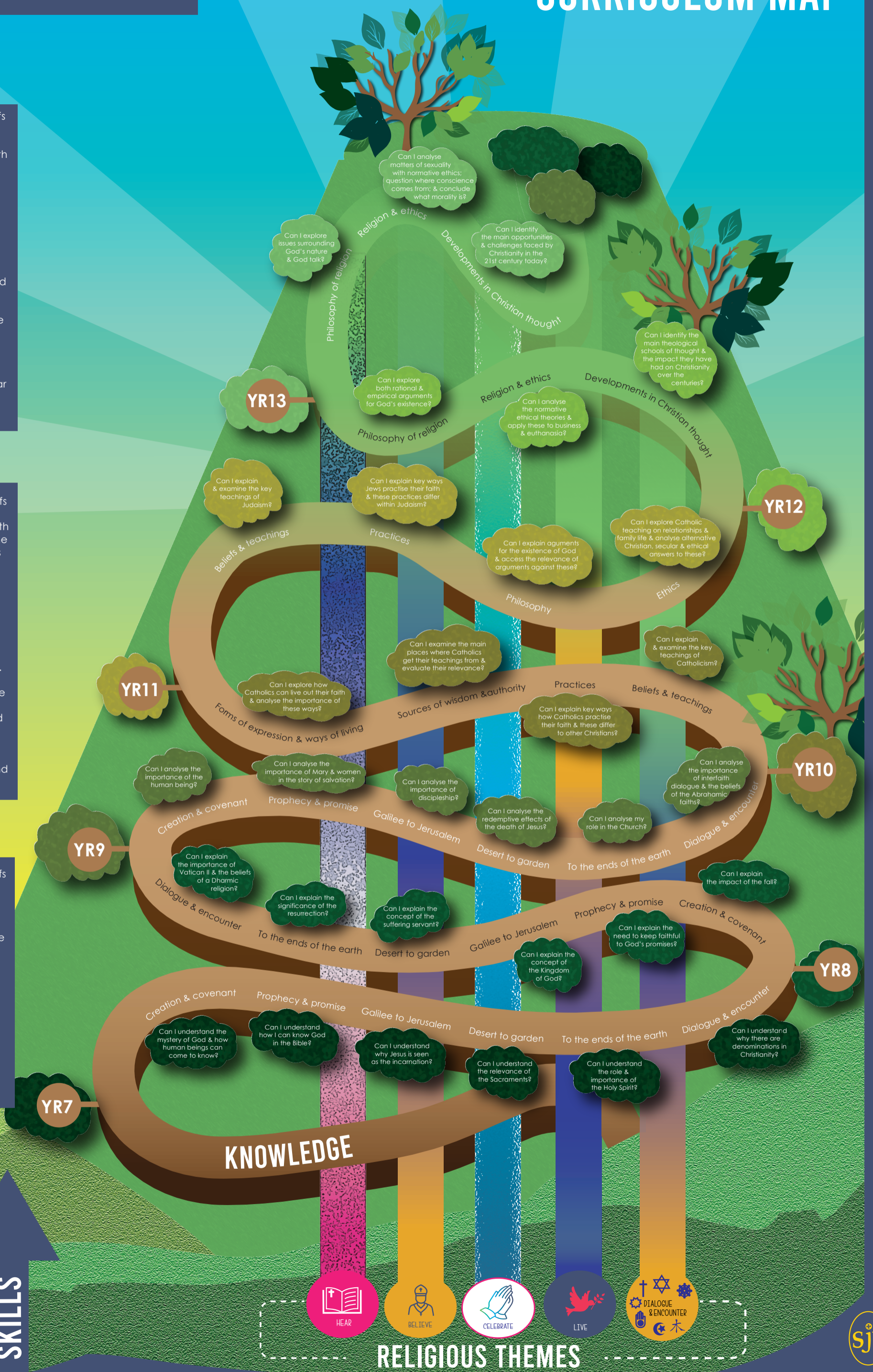
I can respond to alternative points of view by either writing or orating balanced arguments with coherent arguments and counter-arguments made with a clear conclusion and line of reason included.
